

First Christian Church Health Safety Assessment Team
Guidance for Live Small Group Activities

- Group size will follow the Governor’s Guidelines for group size (currently ≤ 10) <http://kycovid19.ky.gov>
- All group members will be instructed to complete a COVID symptom self-assessment prior to attending any activity and will stay home if they have any symptoms or have tested positive for COVID-19. Do not attend if they have had a close contact with someone with symptoms of or are positive for COVID-19. Recommendations are that they stay home and self-monitor for 14 days. All persons would be encouraged to self-report to their group leader or FCC office staff if they were to become positive so other group members can follow appropriate protocols.
 - Self-assessment: Do you have any of the following?
 - Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea or vomiting
 - Diarrhea
- Masks are required by all group members
- Social distancing (at least 6 feet) is required inside and outside on the FCC premises.
 - Only one person at a time will use the restroom facilities.
- Do not share objects
- Follow recommendations for handwashing-frequent handwashing with soap and water. If unavailable, hand sanitizer.

- All group participants will sign-in for each meeting and the leader will provide the final attendance list for the group to the church office and will be maintained by the church office for use with contact tracing if needed.
- If possible, consider holding the activity outdoors
- Do not offer any self-serve food options.
- Per church policy during COVID, each area will only be used by one group per day to allow for adequate cleaning and disinfecting the commonly touched areas.
- All garbage will be placed in provided trash receptacles or taken with the person when leaving FCC.
